



SUBMITTING A CHALLENGE FOR CPF

- Challenge is based on preventing infrastructure overbuild.
- Challengers will submit evidence to show that corresponding locations are currently served.
- Challenge submission includes:
 - A spreadsheet of National Broadband Map Location ID's to be challenged (.CSV File Format)
 - Corresponding written evidence to show that the locations being challenged are currently served.

AFTER A CHALLENGE IS SUBMITTED

- Once challenges are submitted, PBDA will notify the entity that is being challenged.
- Challenged entities will have the opportunity to submit rebutting evidence.
- Challenging and rebutting evidence are then adjudicated and PBDA will notify both challenging and challenged entities of adjudication outcome.


CHALLENGE TYPES

- Challenges may be submitted to correspond to the following challenge types:
 - 1. Speed Based on Speedtests
 - 2. Availability of Service (Existing Service)
 - 1. Physical Service Provision
 - 2. Fixed Wireless Availability
 - 3. Planned Provision of Service
 - 1. ISP plans to buildout service to that area within 1 year.
 - 4. Enforceable Commitments
 - 1. Grant funding commitment for infrastructure buildout
 - 2. E.x.: RDOF, UHSB, CAF-II, ARPA, etc.

- 2.8.24 3.10.24: Final Determination & Award Notification
