# **Digital Connectivity Technology Program**

### A Capital Projects Fund Program

### Overview

The U.S. Department of Treasury awarded \$279 million to Pennsylvania for critical capital projects. In June 2022, the Pennsylvania General Assembly appropriated this funding to the <u>Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority</u> (PBDA), which is using the funds to establish grant programs that identify eligible projects that meet program guidelines and federal requirements.

The <u>CPF-Digital Connectivity Technology</u> <u>Program (Technology)</u> is one of the three funding programs created by PBDA to help deploy these funds in communities across Pennsylvania.

### Who Can Apply

- Community Anchor Institutions (CAIs)
- Municipalities and Local Government Institutions
- Non-profits
- Previous applicants who were unsuccessful may apply
- Previous applicants who were successful and did not receive the maximum amount of laptops (200) may apply

## **Eligible Projects**

Projects will include the acquisition of laptop devices that facilitate broadband internet access and promote digital literacy and skills training.

### Funding

In June 2024, the PBDA opened the \$20 million competitive Technology grant program and accepted applications through August 2024. The program allowed for eligible applicants to request a minimum of 20 and a maximum of 200 laptops. Grantees will not receive grant money.

The PBDA will be reopening the Technology Program, for a second round of applications.
