Overview

To increase opportunity for broadband infrastructure investment within Pennsylvania, the PBDA created the [Broadband Ready Communities \(BBRC\)](#) Program.

The BBRC encourages municipalities to review policies, procedures, and permitting with the goal of reducing barriers to building broadband infrastructure. High-speed broadband enables remote work, telehealth, career advancement, and startups.

Joining the BBRC Program is optional but strongly encouraged.
