To increase opportunity for broadband infrastructure investment within Pennsylvania, the PBDA created the <u>Broadband Ready Communities</u> (<u>BBRC</u>) Program.

The BBRC encourages municipalities to review polices, procedures, and permitting with the goal of reducing barriers to building broadband infrastructure. High-speed braodband enables remote work, telehealth, career advancement, and startups.

Joining the BBRC Program is optional but strongly encouraged.

- Expedite broadband deployment in your municipality
- Declare to Internet Service Providers that your community wants high-speed internet
